Re: The Community Council, September 10, 2014, Records Request

Dear Mr. Carmon:

One month ago, on October 14, 2014, I wrote to you to inform you of deficiencies in the County's response to my client's September 10, 2014, public records request to your office. To date, I have not received a response to my October 14, 2014, letter, and my client has received no supplemental production from the County.

You will recall, my client requested records of all expenses paid directly or indirectly on behalf of the County Manager and all Commissioners for the past five years, itemized per individual. The law obligates you to provide these records in "any and all media in which [you are] capable of providing them." N.C. Gen. Stat. § 132-6.2 (a). My client sought "for this information to be provided in electronic format, on a disk or thumb drive."

Moreover, review of the records you provided indicates they are incomplete. My client requested five years of records. You have produced to them only approximately 2.5 years of records. My client is willing to accept a full three years of records as a satisfactory response to its request.

My client is committed to retrieving these records. Please provide supplemental production including three full years of responsive electronic records as promptly as possible, as required by law.
